## VOTING PAPER

At the AGM to be held on 16<sup>th</sup> September 2014, a decision will be taken as to whether tattooing should remain compulsory or become optional. This decision will be made on the basis of a postal vote only. There will not be a vote taken at the AGM.

Members must understand unequivocally what they are voting for is:

Either

- a) Tattooing of pedigree ear numbers as described in the Society's current Regulations for Registrations in the Flock Book should continue to be **compulsory** in addition to the statutory tagging arrangements.

Or

- b) Tattooing of pedigree ear numbers as described in the Society's current Regulations for Registrations in the Flock Book should be **optional** but given the absence of legible tattoos, the flock code, year letter and individual number must be included on the statutory tags or an additional management tag.

In either case, lambs must be fully identified in both ears by NOT LATER THAN 15<sup>TH</sup> JUNE in the year of their birth.
